

STATEMENT OF WORK

Wild Horse and Burro Ammunition Purchase

Colorado and Utah Field Offices | Bureau of Land Management

1. Background and Purpose

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) manages free-roaming wild horses and burros on public lands as part of its multiple-use mission, with the goal of supporting healthy wild horses and burros on healthy public rangelands. The BLM is responsible for determining and maintaining appropriate management levels (AML) for each herd BLM Colorado manages four wild horse herd management areas (HMAs) on approximately 400 thousand acres. The combined appropriate management level for all HMAs in the state is 812 animals. BLM Utah manages 19 wild horse and burro herd management areas on nearly 2.5 million acres. The combined appropriate management level for all HMAs in the state is 1,956 animals.

2. Purpose

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Colorado and Utah Wild Horse and Burro (WHB) Program require commercial rifle and hollow-point pistol ammunition for the humane euthanasia of wild horses and burros. Euthanasia actions are conducted in accordance with:

- BLM Manual H-4700, Section 4.9 — Humane Destruction
- Policy Instruction Memorandum (PIM) 2021-007 — Euthanasia of Wild Horses and Burros Related to Acts of Mercy, Health or Safety

This Statement of Work (SOW) establishes the specifications, delivery requirements, and quality standards applicable to this one-time commercial item purchase.

3. Period of Performance

This is a one-time delivery order. The period of performance is from date of award through September 30, 2026, or such later date as authorized by the Contracting Officer in writing.

4. Scope of Work

The contractor shall furnish, package, and deliver factory-new commercial ammunition in the calibers, quantities, bullet configurations, and packaging specifications listed in Section 4. All rounds must be factory-new, commercially manufactured, and free of defects.

This is a firm-fixed-price purchase. No Government-Furnished Property (GFP) or Government-Furnished Equipment (GFE) will be provided.

5. Requirements

5.1 Bullet Type — Mandatory

Where noted ammunition furnished under this order SHALL be hollow point (HP) or expanding projectile type. The following projectile types are STRICTLY PROHIBITED and will result in rejection of the entire delivery:

- Full Metal Jacket (FMJ)

- Round Nose (RN) / Lead Round Nose (LRN)
- Total Metal Jacket (TMJ)
- Flat Nose (FN) non-expanding

Acceptable expanding projectile designations include but are not limited to: JHP (Jacketed Hollow Point), CPHP (Copper Plated Hollow Point), BTSP (Boat Tail Soft Point), ISP (InterLock Soft Point), ELD-X (Extremely Low Drag — eXpanding), PP (Power Point), and equivalent commercial expanding designs.

5.2 Quality Standards

- All ammunition shall be factory-new, in original sealed boxes.
- No remanufactured, reloaded, pulled, or surplus military ammunition will be accepted.
- All rounds shall be free of corrosion, deformation, or other visible defects.
- Ammunition shall conform to SAAMI (Sporting Arms and Ammunition Manufacturers' Institute) standards for the applicable caliber.

5.3 Labeling and Packaging

- All boxes shall be clearly labeled with caliber, grain weight, bullet type, manufacturer name, and lot number.
- Individual boxes shall be packed in manufacturer's standard cartons or cases for shipping.
- No mixing of calibers within a single shipping box or carton is permitted.

6. Contract Line Items (CLINs) - Ammunition Specifications

The contractor shall deliver all CLINs listed below. Quantities are firm. Partial deliveries are not permitted unless authorized in writing by the Contracting Officer.

7. Delivery Requirements

7.1 Delivery Address

7.2 Delivery Schedule

All CLINs shall be delivered no later than September 30, 2026, or as otherwise directed in writing by the Contracting Officer. Time is of the essence.

7.3 Delivery Notification

The contractor shall provide written advance notice of shipment (including tracking number(s), carrier, and estimated delivery date) to the COR at least 48 hours prior to delivery.

7.4 Inspection and Acceptance

Inspection and acceptance will be performed at destination by the Contracting Officer's Representative (COR). The Government reserves the right to reject any ammunition that does not conform to the specifications in Section 4 or the restrictions in Section 3. Rejected items shall be removed at the contractor's expense and replaced with conforming items within 10 calendar days of notice of rejection.

8. Special Instructions

- No full metal jacket (FMJ) or round nose (RN) ammunition will be accepted under any circumstances.
- Contractor must coordinate delivery schedule directly with the COR (Lynae Rogers) at least 48 hours in advance.
- All shipments shall include a packing list identifying CLIN number, caliber, quantity, manufacturer, lot number, and total boxes per CLIN.
- Ammunition shall be packaged to prevent shifting, damage, or moisture intrusion during transit.
- The contractor is responsible for compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations governing the sale and shipment of ammunition.
